The arms are noticeably different from classical flamenco, curving around the head and body rather than extending, often with a bent elbow. The emphasis for both male and female performers is on lightning-fast footwork performed with absolute precision. Therefore, unlike other dance forms, where dancers turn professional early to take advantage of youth and strength, many El Andaluz - Guitar dancers do not hit their peak until their thirties and will continue to perform into their fifties and .

There is less virtuoso technique in gitanoflamenco, but the music and steps are choreographed and include influences from other dance styles. The guitarist uses techniques like strumming rasgueado or tapping the soundboard golpe.
